**Title II Construction Inspection Services
Ellsworth Air Force Base SD**

As the Inspection Contractor, Project Solutions has performed all services required for coordination, daily surveillance and inspection throughout the performance period of assigned construction contracts up to completion and the final inspection of the Construction Task Orders. In addition Project solutions is responsible for reporting to and to work through the designated 28 CES Project Manager (PM) or Construction Manager (CM) who is the designated technical representative for the 28 CCS Contracting Officer.

Project Solutions is also responsible for the reviewing of documentation and submittals including shop drawings, test results, certificates, warranties, and material samples. We also maintain a file for each project, daily log book about the job site activity, detailed monthly report, a construction deficiency list and digital color photographs of the construction including before and after pictures. We also participate in both the pre-final and final inspections for each project.

Project Solutions Inc. was selected by the Air Force for its ability to provide design review, quality control inspections coupled with detailed reports, quality assurance oversight of the contractors quality control and safety plans, and our ability to blanket cover the widely diverse individual work elements contained in the project.
